Yes, schools are involved in the activity, and teachers are very much in favor because this is not only an opportunity for boys and girls with disabilities, but also for the others who have to coordinate the team, which means showing responsibility and respect towards their teammates.

Andrea Puccinelli is an able-bodied player who played for the San Leonardo in Treponzio school team that won the 2017 tournament. When I asked him about the experience, he said: What it gives me is the awareness that disabled kids are no different from me; they want to run and jump just like me and they want to win, probably even more than me!

As you can see, in terms of awareness it works very well. So make sure you find the time to come and enjoy the next tournament!
